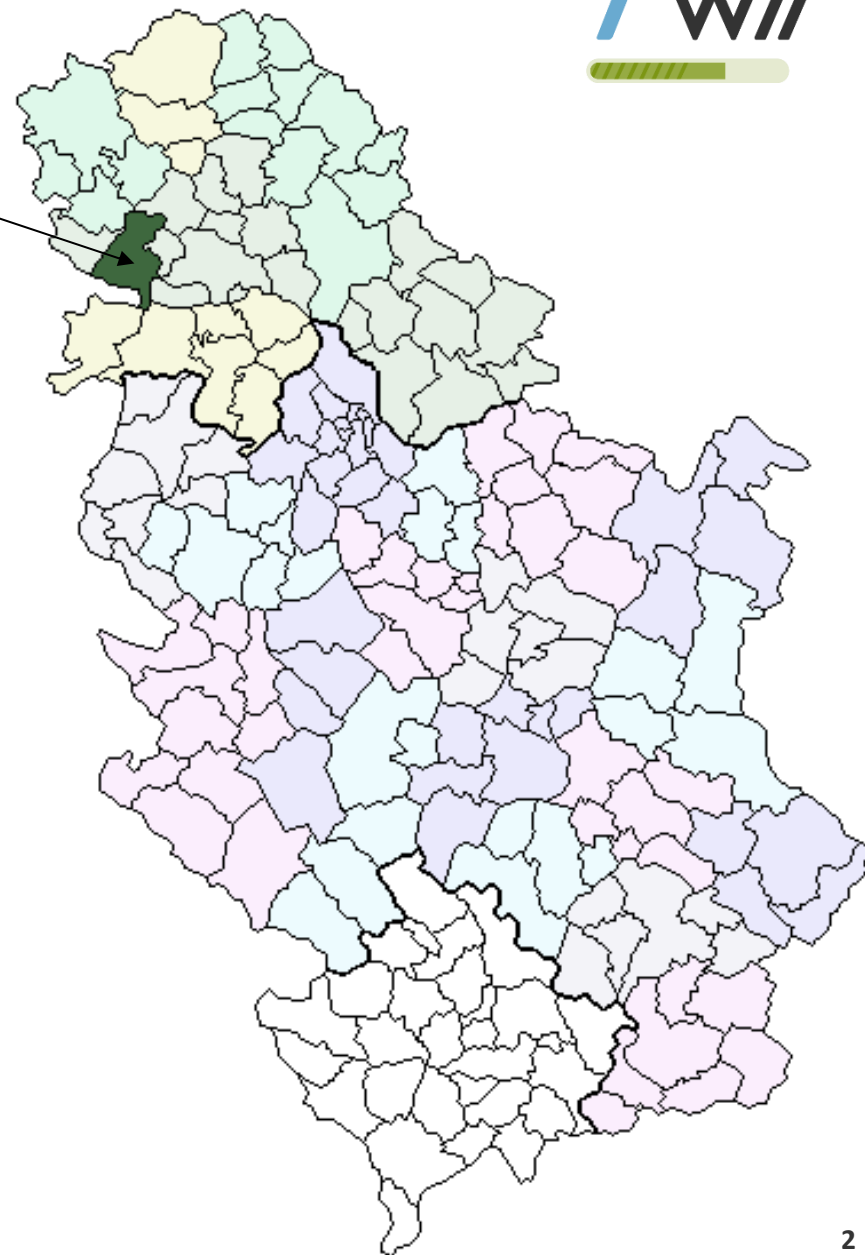

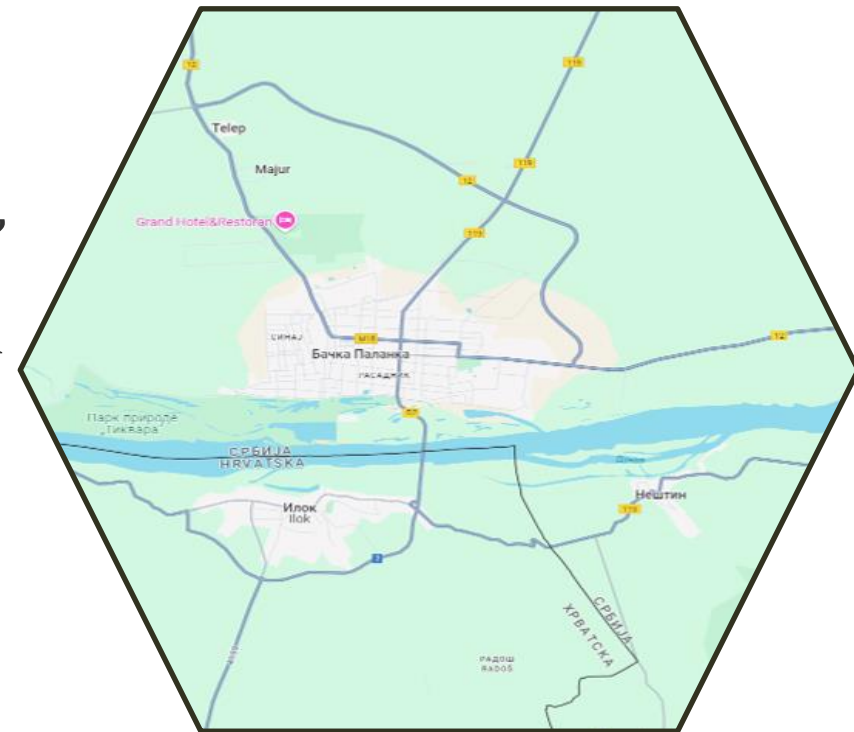

- ▶ Bačka Palanka is a local municipality in the Republic of Serbia, located in Autonomous Province of Vojvodina
- ▶ The territory of the municipality covers an area of 579 km²
- ▶ The center of the municipality is the Bačka Palanka town, and besides it, there is 9 more settlements



- ▶ Bačka Palanka is located on the banks of the Danube River on the border with the Republic of Croatia
- ▶ It is located 40 km west of Novi Sad, 122 km northwest of Belgrade, 107 km south of Subotica, 323 km south of Budapest and 564 km southeast of Vienna.
- ▶ At the 1297th kilometer of the Danube River, there is the "25th of May" bridge that connects Bačka Palanka and the town of Ilok in the Republic of Croatia (EU).





- ▶ According to the last census 55,528 people live and work in the in the municipality
- ▶ The most numerous are Serbs, Slovaks and Hungarians
- ▶ In addition to the Serbian language, the Slovak language is also officially used in the municipality
- ▶ City across the Danube is Ilok, with great wine history
- ▶ Bačka Palanka is an agricultural area where wheat, corn, soybeans and hops are mostly grown
- ▶ Although they are separated only by the Danube, these two cities have completely different agricultural activities





- ▶ There are several factories in Palanka, primarily wood, electrical and food industries
- ▶ The natural good of „Tikvara“ is located in the area of the middle course of the Danube, on its left bank, from 1927th to 1305th km
- ▶ Lake „Tikvara“ is a natural lake on the Danube formed by displacement of the flow of the Danube, and it got its name from the boats in which fishermen kept their fish
- ▶ Today it is used for swimming, fishing and holding sports events on the water





- ▶ „Grand hotel & restaurant“ was opened last year
- ▶ It is located in the northern part of the Bačka Palanka municipality, and not far from hotel is Karađorđevo, a well-known hunting ground in the Republic of Serbia and the former Yugoslavia
- ▶ Karađorđevo is also known for its stable of horses, the largest in the country and in this part of Europe
- ▶ You will hear more about the Danube sector near Bačka Palanka this afternoon
